Agricultural sector

Policy statement:

Government to facilitate sustainable crop and livestock development to meet the targets of our Agricultural Development Strategy by 2011 without compromising human health and environment.

• Policy objective:

- 1. To achieve 100% local production in poultry and pork as well as valorizing other type of livestock incl. small ruminants.
- 2. To achieve at least 70% of anable crop requirements.

General strategy

Government to act as a facilitator in the following areas:

- Services & institutional support
- Marketing
- Production
- Requisites
- Farm certification scheme (Bio Security)
- Hatchery, feed factory & abattoir
- Poultry parent stock farm
- Provision of genetic resources (breeding stock)

General strategy cont'd

- Land
- Revision of legislations
- Farm waste management
- Disease prevention
- Harmonization of SPS issues

- Production
 Poultry: Broiler 2 500 tons/year to meet demand by 2011 Layer – from current 19 M to 22M eggs/year by 2011
 - Pork: 1 500 tons/year to meat demands in fresh & processed pork
 - Beef: new blood lines to be introduced to increase the local production which in 2005 met only 2.8% of demand
 - Goat meat: new blood lines to be introduced to meet demand which is 25 tons /year
 - Fruits, vegetables & root crop to obtain 75% of demand

Food safety

Consumer protection and food safety will be maintained through the following:

- Animal (Diseases & Imports) Act
- Export of fishery Products Act
- Seychelles Bureau of Standards Act
- Food Act (Ministry of Health)
- Licensing Act
- Plant Protection Act (Under review)
- Environmental Protection Act

- Competition for land

Challenges cont'd

- Land agricultural production zones will be demarcated and protected.
- Effluent disposal improvement in the management of waste in pig production zones & pesticides/fertilizer run off
- Disease prevention good farming practices
- Genetic resources importation of new blood lines, germplasm & setting up of poultry parent stock
- Legislation review, updating & enforcement
- Finance low interest loans to farmers

Veterinary public health issues

- Animal and public health issues will not be compromised in order to achieve the 2011 objectives.
- Farm certification scheme, veterinary interventions, updating & enforcement of legislations (reporting of suspect disease outbreaks, slaughtering, processing & sales of meat), veterinary drugs residue monitoring
- Strengthening of the Veterinary services and other agencies involved in food production and food safety
- Close collaboration with the livestock farmers association




Poultry - Local, Import & Total Consumption 1988 - 2006
